Mr. Bell made a motion to approve the off-site permit. Mr. Hall seconded the motion and it passed unanimously 3-0.

There was discussion regarding the background checks process on individuals applying for beer permits and the fact that they only provide information recorded in the state of Tennessee. City Manager Ellis suggested that he gather more information to be brought back before the Board at the next meeting for further discussion.
